
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of the Committee for the Assessment of Foreign Participation in the United States Telecommunications Service Sector ("the Committee"), the U.S. Department of Justice ("USDOJ") requests that the Commission refer the above-referenced application to the Committee for review pursuant to Executive Order ("E.O.") 13913, to determine whether this application poses a risk to the national security or law enforcement interests of the United States. USDOJ believes that such risk may be raised by the foreign participation (including the foreign relationships and ownership) associated with the application, and a review by the Committee is necessary to assess and make an appropriate recommendation as to how the Commission should adjudicate this application. As with any application that is referred to the Committee, USDOJ further requests that the Commission defer action on this application until the Committee has concluded its review.
